

WHY DO WE USE INCENSE AT MASS?

Everything in Catholic liturgies symbolizes a theological truth—nothing is superfluous or "just for show."

From the 150 passages and others in scripture that speak of incense and worship, we can infer that incense was part of a ritual cleansing and purification of the sacred space of the Tabernacle, making it a worthy place for the worship of God according to His divine terms. In fact, frankincense - mentioned frequently in the Bible - is now known to have antiseptic and disinfectant properties.

Incense smoke symbolically purifies all that it touches.

God gave specific liturgical instructions to Moses because the worship of God in His earthly Tabernacle was a pattern of the worship of God by the angels in His heavenly throne; that is, worship on earth was intended to be united with the worship taking place in heaven. In the Bible, we clearly see incense used in the heavenly worship. When the thurifer incenses the church and the people as he processes into the church he offers frankincense and myrrh to the Christ child once again, all while cleansing and purifying our sacred space, preparing it for the sacred liturgy. As the incense burns, it becomes de-materialized; the incense rises and spreads up and out to heaven symbolizing the prayers of the people rising up to God.

A Catholic solemn Mass, when properly done, will appeal to all the human senses to pull the whole person, body, mind, and soul, into the worship of God. The eye is moved by the architecture, stained glass, vestments, paintings, sculpture, and decorations. The ear is caught by the music, bells and the chant. Knees bend and fingers touch the forehead, chest, and shoulders as the rubrics are performed. The fragrant haze of the incense drifts through the building and is inhaled.

"Incense is the symbol of prayer. Like pure prayer it has in view no object of its own; it asks nothing for itself. It rises like the Gloria at the end of a psalm in adoration and thanksgiving to God for his great glory".






