

The tradition celebrates the charity of St. Joseph by inviting people to bring food for the disenfranchised and place it on a table where a statue of St. Joseph is placed.


The donations Mass with Bishop Brennan will be live streamed from Holy Spirit Church, Fresno on March 17th at 10:00 a.m.
